<p>As a family, read Mark 1:12-13.</p> <p>Ask each family member to share something that jumped out at them after reading this section of scripture.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:12-13. Then, turn to Hebrews 4:14-16.</p> <p>Parents, share a time when you struggled with temptation. Did you resist?</p> <p>Jesus was tempted in the desert for 40 days and nights (Matthew 4:1-11). How does it feel knowing that Jesus was tempted just like you?</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:12-13.</p> <p>Jesus experienced temptation in the flesh as a human.</p> <p>Temptation can be defined as the desire, or wish, to do something that you should not. Jesus was offered many desirable things from the devil, yet he resisted every time.</p> <p>Discuss as a family the importance of Jesus enduring temptation but not falling into sin.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:12-13.</p> <p><u>Application:</u></p> <p>As you learned more about temptation, share, together as a family, an area where you feel temptation.</p> <p>How can you use scripture to help you resist those temptations just as Christ did?</p> <p>Remember, we have a Savior who understands and empathizes with our temptations!</p>	<p>Continue to memorize and worship together to our hymn this month:</p> <p>Solid Rock Hymn Lyrics</p> <p><u>January Memory Verse:</u></p> <p>"Immediately coming up out of the water, He saw the heavens opening, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon Him; and a voice came out of the heavens: "You are My beloved Son, in you I am well-pleased."
