<p>As a family, read Mark 2:13-17</p> <p>Ask each family member to share something that jumped out at them after reading this section of scripture.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 2:13-17</p> <p>Then, turn to John 3:16, 17 [**Make it fun...who can find it first?]</p> <p>Compare the verses in John to Mark 2:17. For what purpose did Jesus say He came into the world?</p> <p>Parents TIP: Instead of answering the question directly, ask your kids questions like "Why do you think..." This is a great way to find out where your kids are coming from and where to guide the conversation to truth!</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 2:13-17</p> <p>Why do you think the scribes and Pharisees were upset that Jesus would eat with "tax collectors and sinners?"</p> <p>What do you think our heart should be toward those who do not know the Lord?</p>	<p>As a family, read Matthew 9:9-13</p> <p>Compare the name of the main character in verse 9, to the name of the main character in Mark 2:14.</p> <p><u>Fun Facts:</u> The name Levi means "joined." The name Matthew means "gift of Jehovah."</p> <p>Do you ever go by more than one name?</p>	<p>Here is a song you can learn as a family to join with us on Sunday in Worshiping the Lord! All Hail the Power of Jesus Name</p> <p><u>March Memory Verse:</u> "And hearing this, Jesus said to them. 'It is not those who are healthy that need a physician, but those who are sick; I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners.'" Mark 2:17</p>
