They rejected who he was and his teachings.</p> <p>How can we make sure to accept and believe what God is doing in our lives (and the lives around us) instead of rejecting and doubting like the religious leaders?</p>	<p>As a family, read Mark 2:1-12.</p> <p>The four men who lowered the paralytic into the home had great faith that their friend would be healed.</p> <p>Do you believe that God still moves and miracles happen today?
