<p>As a family, read Mark 3:1-6</p> <p>Think back to Mark 2:23-28 when the disciples picked the heads of grain on the Sabbath. (Letter of the Law vs Spirit of the Law)</p> <p>Talk with your family about why they were watching Jesus so carefully.</p>	<p>As a family, read Mark 3:1-6</p> <p>Read Matthew 12:9-14. Jesus asks the people, which is more important, to save, (saving a sheep) or to kill (not saving a sheep) on the Sabbath?</p> <p>The religious authorities were supposed to be shepherding the people. Parents: Lead a discussion about what it means to be a good shepherd. Did the leaders do this well?</p>	<p>As a family, read Mark 3:1-6</p> <p>Read Mark 12:29-31</p> <p>Jesus was challenged by the pharisees about not keeping the law on the Sabbath. Later in Mark, Jesus reminds them of the first two commandments.</p> <p>Based on the commandments he quotes, why do you think Jesus grieved for the religious leaders?</p>	<p>As a family, read Mark 3:1-6</p> <p>The bible tells us that Jesus spent time in synagogues teaching. Some skeptics didn't think synagogues existed until after Jesus' life. Well, the oldest synagogue discovered is believed to be from the second century BCE in Modi'in, Israel</p>  <p>Khirbet Umm el-Umdan (ancient synagogue ruins)</p>	<p>Here is a song you can learn as a family to join with us on Sunday in Worshiping the Lord! Holy, Holy, Holy</p> <p><u>May Memory Verse:</u> "For whoever does the will of God, he is My Brother, and sister and mother." Mark 3:35</p>
