Then turn to Matthew 12:22-32</p> <p>People were beginning to conspire (planning to commit a harmful act) against Jesus.</p> <p>Why do you think this was happening? What was Jesus doing that was so different?</p> <p>In what ways do you see people trying to discredit Jesus today?</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 3:20-30.</p> <p><u>Blasphemy</u>- the act of insulting or showing a lack of respect and honor for God.</p> <p>Jesus speaks of an unforgivable sin, which is blasphemy against the Holy Spirit.</p> <p>Why do you think this sin is unforgivable and considered an eternal sin?</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 3:20-30.</p> <p><u>Application:</u> Do you know someone who opposes (is against) Jesus?</p> <p>Parents: Take a moment and share someone you know as well. As a family, commit to praying for those people that came to mind. Ask God to reveal to them their opposition to Christ, and that their hearts would be changed.</p>	<p>Here is a song you can learn as a family to join with us on Sunday in worshipping the Lord!</p> <p>Holy, Holy, Holy</p> <p><u>May Memory Verse:</u> "For whoever does the will of God, he is My brother and sister and mother."
