<p>As a family, read <a href="#">Mark 3:13-19</a></p> <p>Ask each family member to share something that jumped out at them after reading this section of scripture.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read <a href="#">Mark 3:13-19</a></p> <p>Then, turn to <a href="#">John 15:1-11</a></p> <p>Parents, this second passage is rather long, so depending on your child(ren)'s age, you may want to break this into several readings or times of the day.</p> <p>How does the second passage help you understand what it means to "abide" in Christ?</p>	<p>As a family, re-read <a href="#">Mark 3:13-19</a></p> <p>Jesus talks about the power of spending time with Him, preaching the Gospel, SO that His disciples could cast out demons and continue saving souls.</p> <p>What does the phrase "being with Jesus" mean to you? What does it look like in your life?</p>	<p>As a family, re-read <a href="#">Mark 3:13-19</a></p> <p><u>Application:</u> Parents: If you don't already, set up a daily quiet time for everyone to be with Jesus. Morning time or at bedtime, whatever works for each person. Spend intentional time reading a passage and praying. "Be with Jesus" consistently this week.
