<p>As a family, read Mark 1:16-20</p> <p>Ask each family member to share something that jumped out at them after reading this section of scripture.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:16-20.</p> <p>Then, turn to Matthew 16:24 [**Make it fun...who can find it first?]</p> <p>Talk as a family about what kind of career or dreams you each have. Where did they come from?</p> <p>Parents: Take some time and pray with each of your children that the Lord would begin to reveal his calling for them.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:16-20.</p> <p>Several of Jesus' disciples had 'jobs' and chose to walk away from them to follow Christ.</p> <p>They even left them "immediately". What does it mean (look like) to obey immediately?</p> <p>Think and discuss what obedience to God looks like at home for each person, starting with parents.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:16-20.</p> <p><u>First-Century Fishermen:</u> Fishing was fundamental in daily life in Galilee. Jesus uses fishing often in his teachings.
