Then, turn to Matthew 16:24  [**Make it funwho can find it first?]  Talk as a family about what kind of career or dreams you each have. Where did they come from?  Parents: Take some time and pray with each of your children that the Lord would begin to reveal his calling for them.	As a family, re-read Mark 1:16-20.  Several of Jesus' disciples had 'jobs' and chose to walk away from them to follow Christ.  They even left them "immediately". What does it mean (look like) to obey immediately?  Think and discuss what obedience to God looks like at home for each person, starting with parents.	As a family, re-read Mark 1:16-20.  First-Century Fishermen: Fishing was fundamental in daily life in Galilee. Jesus uses fishing often in his teachings. (Click on the link below to see more this actual boat found in Galilee)  What is the difference between a fisherman' and 'fishers of men'?
