<p>As a family, read Mark 1:35-39</p> <p>Ask each family member to share something that jumped out at them after reading this section of scripture.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:35-39</p> <p>Then, turn to John 7:18 [**Make it fun...who can find it first?]</p> <p>After reading these verses, discuss as a family why Jesus might have left a place where everyone was looking for him.</p> <p>Parents TIP: Instead of answering the question directly, ask your kids questions like "Why do you think..." This is a great way to find out where your kids are coming from and where to guide the conversation to truth!</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:35-39</p> <p>If Jesus went away to spend time praying to the Father, what significance should prayer be in the life of a believer?</p> <p>Discuss why you think Jesus went into synagogues to preach and heal and not stay on the streets.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 35-39</p> <p>Jesus left the "popular crowds" where he was sought after to fulfill the will of the Father--preaching the gospel.</p> <p><u>Application:</u> Is it difficult to walk away from popularity or people seeking your attention to do what God is asking you to do?</p> <p>Parents: Be open about what obedience to the Lord has looked like for you.</p>	<p>Here is a song you can learn as a family to join with us on Sunday in Worshiping the Lord! <u>All Hail the Power of Jesus Name</u></p> <p><u>March Memory Verse:</u> "And hearing this, Jesus said to them. 'It is not those who are healthy that need a physician, but those who are sick; I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners.'" Mark 2:17</p>
