What are some differences?</p> <p>Talk as a family about any questions that come up.</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:1-8.</p> <p><u>Forerunner:</u> Something or someone that comes before another</p> <p>What evidence does this passage show about John being the forerunner to Christ?</p> <p>Why was this important in Jesus' ministry?</p>	<p>As a family, re-read Mark 1:1-8.</p> <p><u>Fun Fact:</u> John lived in the desert and wore camel's hair and ate locusts-- EWW</p>  <p>Why do you think he dressed and ate this way?
